Paris Celebrates a Decade of LIT Awards Excellence.

Lighting professionals from around the world gathered in Paris on 16 June 2026 for the tenth edition of the LIT Lighting Design Awards. The anniversary event celebrated outstanding achievements in architectural lighting, product design and entertainment lighting.

The ceremony took place aboard Yachts de Paris on the Seine, offering guests a spectacular view of the Eiffel Tower. What began as an industry awards program has grown into a major international gathering for lighting designers and innovators.
